Academic Background

- What university or institution have you been accepted into?
- What degree program are you planning to pursue in the US?

- Have you taken any steps to strengthen your ties to your home country, such as obtaining employment or securing property?
- What ties do you have to your home country, such as a job, family, or property?

Language Proficiency

- What is your level of proficiency in English?
- Have you taken any English language proficiency tests, such as TOEFL or IELTS?
- How will you manage to communicate with others and participate in classes if you are not fluent in English?
- Can you provide evidence of your English language proficiency, such as test scores or certifications?

Background Information

- Have you ever been to the US before? If so, for what purpose?

- Can you explain the reason why your previous student visa application was rejected?
- Did you receive any specific reasons or explanations for the rejection?
- What steps have you taken to address the reasons for the rejection?
